4. Linda has 39 marbles. Diana has 13 times as many marbles as Linda has. How many marbles does Linda and Diana have?
5. Ron, Jack, Jason and Tim each have 2, 3, 5 and 6 dozen baseball cards respectively. How many baseball cards do they have in all?
6. Bill makes \$12.50 an hour cleaning houses. If he works from 8 am to 4 pm, how much money will he make?
7. Dorothy bought 24 dozen eggs from the supermarket to bake some cakes. If she used 15 eggs how many eggs are left with Dorothy?
8. Chelsea has 34 balloons. Brenda has 20 times as many balloons as Chelsea has. How many balloons does Chelsea and Brenda have?
9. Bob earns \$18 per hour cleaning windows. If he works 4 hours and spends \$25 on food, how much money does he have now?
10. Mary saw 10 dozen birds sitting on a tree. If 7 pairs of birds fly away, how many birds are there on the tree now?
